

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets NSPA's Winning Candidates, Affirms Commitment to Constitutional Entitlements, Joint Work



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met on Sunday evening, December 14, 2025, at His office in Baghdad with the victorious candidates of the National State Powers' Alliance in the recent elections. H.E. congratulated them on the Federal Supreme Court's endorsement of the election results, describing it as a constructive step toward completing constitutional obligations in the upcoming stage.
