

Sayyid Al-Hakeem From Mar Gorgis Church Congratulates Christmas, Affirms Christian Community Iraq Authenticity



From the Mar Gorgis Chaldean Catholic Church in Baghdad Al-Jadeeda District, His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, extended Christmas greetings on Thursday morning, 25 December 2025, to Christians in Iraq and around the world. H.E. affirmed that the birth of Jesus Christ (peace be upon Him and upon our Prophet and his family) represents a universal humanitarian message shared by all divine religions and is not confined to a single community or faith.
