

Sayyid Al-Hakeem on Aziz Al-Iraq Passing Anniversary: Project Made with Martyrs Blood, Steadfast Positions to Defend Country, Elections



At the memorial ceremony commemorating seventeenth anniversary passing of Aziz Al-Iraq, His Eminence Sayyid Abdul Aziz Al-Hakeem (may Allah sanctify his soul), held by Iraqi Islamic Supreme Council, His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, congratulated attendees and Iraqi people on arrival of blessed month of Ramadan.
